




# SUMMER CAMP PRE-VISIT GUIDE

# WELCOME TO CAMP

# BEFORE I ARRIVE

Before I arrive, I will make sure to prepare myself for challenges and think of ways to help make my day at camp fun!

# WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

It is a good idea for me to bring a water bottle, a lunch, a bag or backpack to carry my things, and a jacket in case I want to wear it later.

# CHECK-IN

Once I have my camp shirt on, I will go to the deck in the play yard and meet my camp educator. It's time to give my adult a hug or high-five and tell them "See you after camp!"

# CAMP SHUTTLE

Because my camp is at Dogwood Canyon, each day I will get on the camp shuttle with my camp educator and my camp friends at Wonders of Wildlife, and ride down to Dogwood Canyon. At Dogwood, I will meet my Dogwood Educator who will take us to the Nature Center to begin our camp for the day.





# MY BELONGINGS

During camp, I will be able to put my things that I brought with me in my classroom. This helps keep my things safe while I am having fun and learning!

# RESTROOMS

The bathrooms in the Nature Center at Dogwood Canyon are just down the hall from the classroom. If I need to use the restroom while I am at camp, I can ask my camp educator and they will let me use the restroom.





# MORNING MEETINGS

Each morning, my camp educator will have a morning meeting with me and my camp friends to tell us what we will be doing during camp. This is also when I will learn what the rules are for being at camp.

# DOGWOOD STORE

If I can follow all the rules and try my hardest, I can earn Dogwood Stamps. I can earn up to 4 Dogwood Stamps per day! I can use these stamps to buy things from the Dogwood Store at the end of the day. There are so many cool things at the Dogwood Store that I can buy with my stamps!




# LUNCH
